SEE Alliance is transforming Florida’s political system through community organizing rooted in school boards.

Founded in Sarasota in 2019, SEE is now a statewide force for education justice and civic change, reaching 53 of Florida’s 67 school districts. Our movement is led by students and supported by educators, neighbors, and everyday Floridians, spanning ages 12-94.
